Friday: Tour of Saluda, North Carolina

Tour fees include motorcoach rental, driver gratuity and admission fees.

Saluda, also known as, "Pace Central" due to its Pace family connections, is a charming town that owes its existence to the railroad and the infamous Saluda Grade. Originally, the settlement was known as Pace's Gap. Burrell Pace was an early settler. Tangie Morgan, the current mayor of Saluda, is a Pace descendant.

The tour will include a visit to Old Mountain Page cemetery where Burrell Pace and many of his descendants are buried; the historic MA Pace store which celebrated its 100th anniversary in 1999; the memorial plaza with bricks honoring Pace pioneers; the Saluda Depot Historical Museum which celebrates the rich history of Saluda; lunch on your own at a Saluda restaurant of your choice with shopping time.

Tour will conclude with a visit to Pearson's Waterfall, a Western NC treasure.
